EaC faculty share at regional summit

Bob Seem and John Callister attended the Rochester Regional Entrepreneurship Summit on November 21 at the University of Rochester along with entrepreneurship faculty from 13 Central and Western New York State colleges and universities. After a sharing of best practices, the group discussed future plans, which include

two meetings in January and March of 2015 and efforts to form collaborations in our communities and between our campuses. The group also voiced support for the NY State Business Plan Competition in Albany on April 24, 2015.

Growth in Entrepreneurship Education

In November, the School of Hotel Administration officially approved a concentration in entrepreneurship, with the help of a steady vision from the entrepreneurship faculty team and on-going support of the faculty teaching entrepreneurship courses at SHA. In addition, the upcoming Winter Session 2015 marks our entry into online entrepreneurship education with two courses being offered.
