Kevin Reilly is responsible for leading the highly rated TNT and TBS networks, guiding Turner's new ventures Super Deluxe and ELeague, and driving opportunities across the Turner Entertainment portfolio, which also includes truTV and Adult Swim. Reilly also sits on the board of Mashable, the recipient of a strategic investment by Turner to bridge opportunities between television and digital.

As one of television's most influential and innovative leaders, Kevin Reilly is the only television executive to have run two broadcast networks and three cable networks. From 2007 to 2014, he served at FOX as head of entertainment leading to an unprecedented seven year run as television's #1 network. As President of Entertainment at NBC from 2004-2007, Reilly championed hits such as *The Office*, *Friday Night Lights* and *30 Rock*. Previously, Reilly served as President of Entertainment at FX where he helped transform the fledgling network into a profitable, creative powerhouse. Prior to FX, Reilly was president at Brillstein-Grey Entertainment.
